## **Instrumental Competition**

The Annual Pasadena Showcase House for the Arts Instrumental Competition was held on March 3, 2024 at the Pasadena Conservatory of Music. Nine finalists performed before a panel of judges from the LA Philharmonic to compete for \$17,500 in prizes, generously underwritten by Kathryn and Charles Hofgaarden. From a pool of 29 applicants, nine finalists, ages 14 to 18, performed for an esteemed panel of judges, all members of the L.A. Philharmonic. The judges faced difficult decisions as they deliberated over the exceptional performances. The Grand Prize for Exceptional Talent and Musicianship was awarded to Hanbo Xu, 16-year old clarinet player from The Webb Schools in Claremont, CA. Hanbo, whose teacher is Burt Hara, is principal clarinet in the Claremont Young Musicians Orchestra. The judges cited his excellent control and technique throughout, with his Stravinsky a "terrific, compelling performance."

Other awards went to Cheng-Yueh (Niccolo) Wu, 1<sup>st</sup> Prize Strings; Chi-Chun (Aurora) Kuo, 1<sup>st</sup> Prize Brass; Esme Arias-Kim, 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize Strings; Vinay Sundar, 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize Woodwinds, Jasper Kugler, 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize Brass, Chloe Yoon, Honorable Mention, Strings; Henry Woodruff, Honorable Mention Strings; and Lilian Walker, our youngest competitor at 14, Honorable Mention Brass. We look forward to seeing many of these students participate again next year.

Over \$685,000 in prize money has been awarded since the Instrument Competition began in 1985. Many of our prizewinners enjoy distinguished careers in classical music. Two former winners are currently members of the L.A. Philharmonic and served as jurors this year – Brent Samuels and Head Judge, Michelle Tseng. The 2017 Grand Prize winner is now Principal Flutist with the Los Angeles Chamber Orchestra. Cellist Jonathan Karoly, 1996 winner is a member of the L.A. Philharmonic. Sheryl Staples, 1988 First Prize Strings winner, is Associate Concertmaster of the New York Philharmonic. Many thanks to our additional judges on our panel this year: Brent Samuel and Tianyun Jia, Strings; Christopher Still and Amy Jo Rhine, Brass; and Carolyn Hove and Taylor Eiffert, Woodwinds.


