Yes, The City of Pasadena Likes Us!

Our Conditional Use Permit (CUP) was approved! On Wednesday evening, February 21, the City of Pasadena approved our petition to create, open for tours for 25,000 people, and then properly close the 2024 Pasadena Showcase House of Design through July 2024.

It was gratifying for us to learn throughout the process of drafting documents and talking with the City and over a dozen officials, that they are happy Pasadena Showcase is returning to Pasadena. It has been seven years since we had a house in our city, Dana Marevich's 2017 House on La Loma.

Many thanks to Permits Co-chairs, Mary Lou Byrne and Bee Campbell, Parking and Transportation Chair Lydia Rubin, Neighbors Chair, Cindy Bengtson, General Ops Co-chairs, Susy Woo and Kassie Douglass, House Ops Chair Jennifer Cratz, and counsel from Matt McIntyre, Vikki Sung, and Lynn Mehl that got us to this pivotal point. And I am grateful, too, to many of you who contributed to sections of the final submission.

But it is a "conditional use permit: with two issues.

- 1. Approval will be final on March 4, if no neighbors raise issues about parking, traffic, or noise.
- 2. We also have 44 items on the "conditions" list. The good news is that the City's requirements are items and reports that we are already working to include in our plans. Mary Lou and Bee will be in touch with some of you soon to complete our paperwork to assure the City we are complying with their requirements.

Lots More Work Ahead

And yes, there is a lot more work ahead. Thank you all for your creativity, consistency, and hard work as we get closer to opening day!
